Newman's Error Analysis

Newman's Error Analysis Steps	Question/ Problem:
1. <u>Reading</u> Read the question	Danny has 8 cars. Mark has three times as many cards as Danny. How many cars does Mark have?
2. <u>Comprehension</u> What is the question asking you to do?	Find out how many cards Mark has
3. <u>Transformation</u> How are you going to find the answer?	8 x 3 or 8 + 8 + 8 =
4. <u>Process skills</u> Do the working out	8 and 8 are 16 and 8 more makes 24
5. <u>Encoding</u> Write the answer to the question	Mark has 24 cars.
